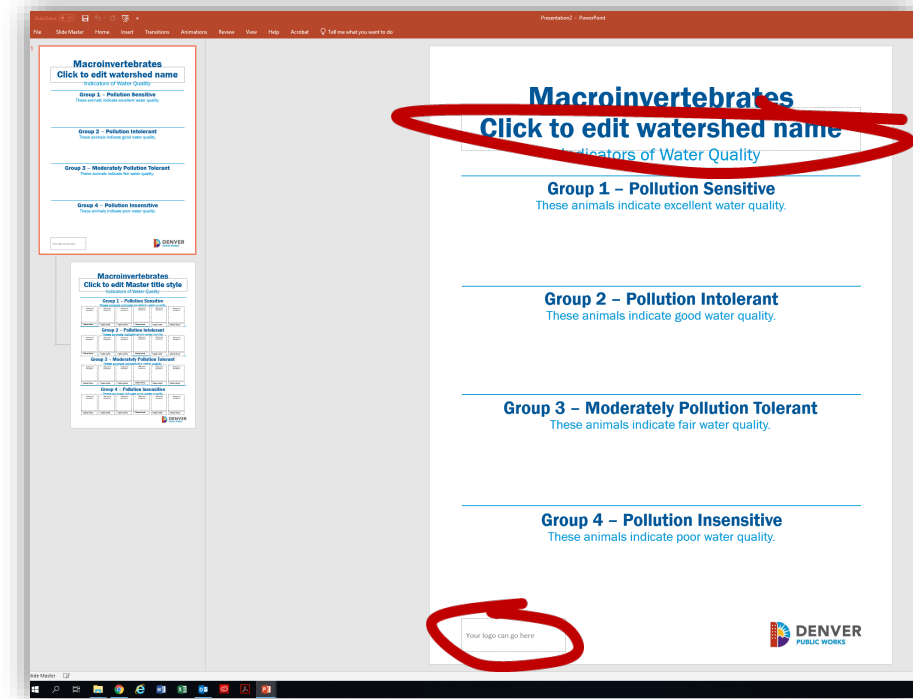
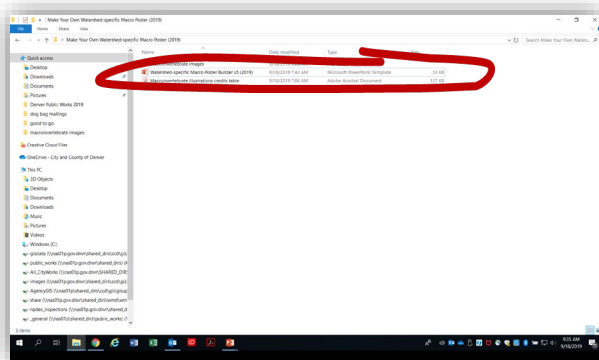


What better suits my watershed?

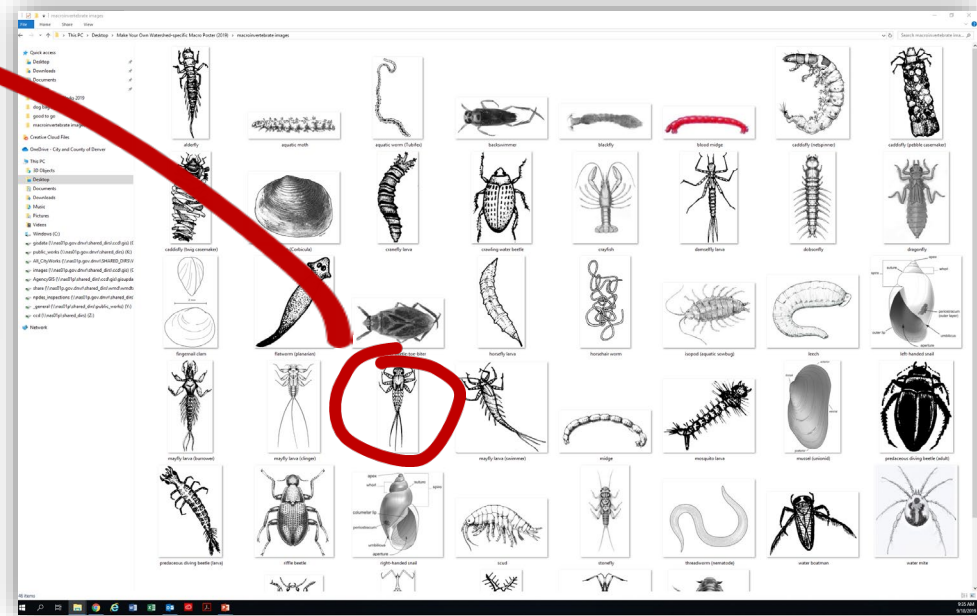
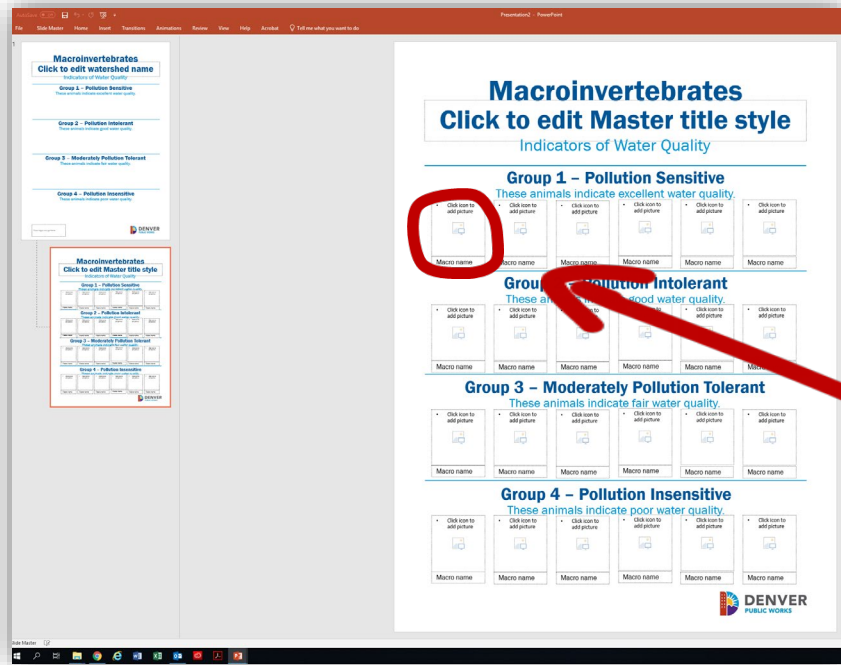
- See, there's *never* been a water penny found in Colorado...

- And, in New Mexico, I find 13 – some new and some in different groups.



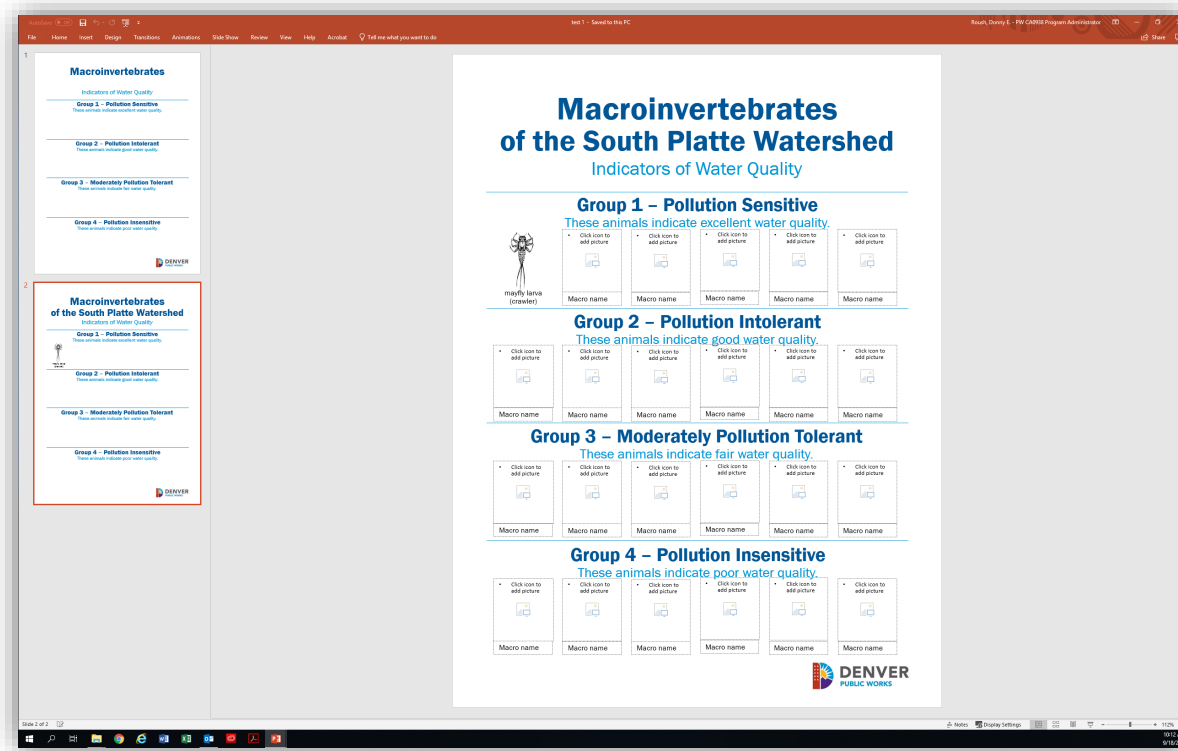

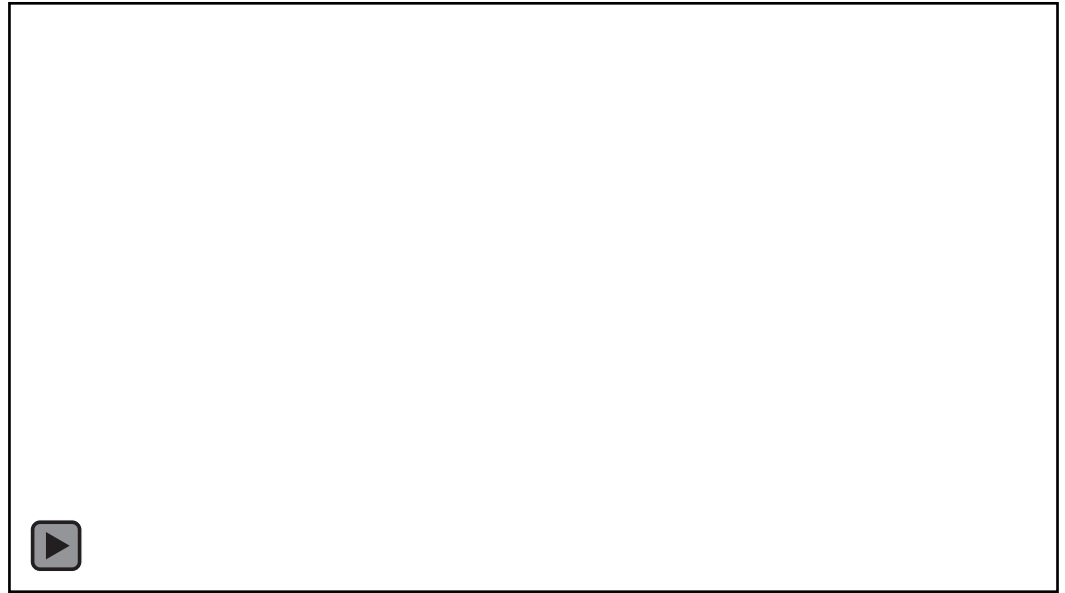
